Children Die, Too

The Doctor Is In Series

No one is ever prepared for a child's death, but there are ways to live through this very sad experience.

This show introduces you to some people who have felt this kind of pain, and who can offer some suggestions for going through the process. A couple whose three-year-old daughter died suddenly, a teenage girl whose sister died from leukemia, a mother whose six-month-old died from multiple birth defects, and a young woman who has lived through two miscarriages and two stillborns talk about their experiences.

Dr. Sandra Fox of the Good Grief program based in Boston, Massachusetts, discusses how people in communities can help each other deal with the death of a child. Pediatric oncology nurse Janet Stewart from the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center explains how a cancer treatment team can help families through a child's terminal diagnosis and treatment. Host Jamie Guth visits an art therapy class for school-aged children, and talks to the teacher, Patti Morgan, about how children express their grief.
